What will we accept this year? Two Categories—General Rubbish and Electronics. Yes we will collect electronics, as we received a number of positive comments from 2015. Listed below are items that will be accepted. Please remember, this is an expense to the Township and you can help by reducing the weight of your items. For example, if you have a large console TV from Bonanza days, see if you can safely remove the TV unit from the console and dispose of the cabinet in General Rubbish. This is one example to encourage you to reduce the weight of the items as the Township is charged by the pound.

There will be two dumpsters for General Rubbish.

2. No Tires.

The Township will collect heavy scrap to be sold to offset some of the cost of Clean-Up Day.

Grove City Council of Governments will also hold a Clean-Up Day including Household Waste sometime in the future (Last year it was held in September). There will be a fee for the waste.
