CLEAN-UP DAY this year will be held on Saturday, August 11, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 A.M.—12:00 noon at the Township Garage. There will be dumpsters for general rubbish and the following are excluded:

- 1. NO Paint Cans unless sealed and dry.
- 2. NO Refrigeration Units unless tagged with an Official Certification Sticker "Freon Removed" from a Registered Technician.
- 3. NO Electronics this year.

We will also be taking **Tires.** NO tires on rims and limited to Car and Light Truck Tires. The Township will assume the fee so please use this opportunity to clean up any tires you are not using.

If you have **Scrap Metal** you wish to donate, we will have a Township Truck parked at the Garage for collection. Also, if you would be interested in helping with Clean-Up Day, please call the Township Office at 814-786-8102.

PROJECTS

The Township received a grant this year in the amount of \$64,174 under the Low Volume Roads Project, through the Mercer County Conservation District, for 1,425 feet of West Gilmore Road. This project allows for proper drainage and improves the road's overall condition. The Township also is providing funds to repair the remaining areas and place Double Seal Coat on the entire road.

Another grant was awarded under the Low Volume Roads Project, in the amount of \$37,400 to Wolf Creek Township, for Driving Surface Aggregate to be placed on 1,540 feet of Old School Road.
